





| Month/Season | Autumn Renewal/Commitment |
|----------------------|---|
| Advent/ Christmas | Generosity, Welcome (many visitors coming soon!) |
| January | Making things new (pastoral letter reflection at all parish meetings and in open gatherings) |
| Lent | Sacrifice, Call-Response |
| Easter | Joy of giving, evangelization and mission |
| Pentecost | The Holy Spirit strengthens us to embrace stewardship (meaning and purpose and our need to give) |
| September | Discipleship and Stewardship, including gifts discernment Gifts and commitment discernment Ministry fair/expo Lay witness |
| October | Annual Renewal/Commitment |
| November | Gratitude, Family |
